The IGNITE 2020 Learning Series is a sequence of highly interactive workshops designed to build stronger and more effective managers and leaders in Indian Country! It teaches skills that are applicable in both professional and personal lives. These programs are tailored to tribal organizations and focuses on many of the success factors of Leadership. This is excellent training for seasoned executive leaders, new supervisors or managers, or anyone wanting to grow into a management position.

SESSION #1: LAYING THE GROUNDWORK: FINDING OUR PURPOSE AND UNLEASHING YOUR PASSION

In this kickoff session we will spend time getting to know each other and setting a foundation for what the deeper purpose of your role is within your organization. We will tap into what makes us feel alive and how we can apply that to our work and positively impact our organization. We will talk about the power of personal responsibility and how a mindset shift can empower you to live a more fulfilling life at work.

SESSION #2: INSPIRING GREATNESS AND IGNITING MEANINGFUL CHANGE

We will review key operating principles, like accountability and support, and provide a set of principles that can be applied to your organizations. We will build a plan to get buy-in and gain momentum around strong productive culture. We will have our first “What’s On Your Mind?” session which will allow us to work through a situation together and demonstrate the things we have discussed in a real life way.

And finally, and in many ways most importantly, we will talk about measurement tools that can be used to ultimately assess and improve employee engagement at your organization.
